MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF NATIONAL APPRAISAL COMMITTEE (NAC) UNDER SCHEME COMPONENT OF 'FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR TAGORE CULTURAL COMPLEXES(TCC)' UNDER "SCHEME OF FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR CREATION OF CULTURAL INFRASTRUCTURE" HELD UNDER THE CHAIRPERSONSHIP OF SECRETARY (CULTURE) ON 28<sup>th</sup> NOV., 2018 AT 11:30 AM AT CONFERENCE HALL, CENTRAL SECRETARIAT LIBRARY, SHASTRI BHAWAN, NEW DELHI.

Meeting of the National Appraisal Committee (NAC) for selection of TCC scheme applications was held under the Chairpersonship of Shri Arun Goel, Secretary (Culture) on 28<sup>th</sup> Nov., 2018 at New Delhi. The list of participants is annexed.

- 2. Chairman welcomed the experts and other ex-officio members to the meeting. He also welcomed AS&FA, Ministry of Culture as a special invitee for the meeting. In his opening remarks he informed the members that the Scheme for Creation of Cultural Infrastructure in States is made with a vision to promote and propagate Art and Culture. The objective of the Scheme is to provide a platform for the artistes to showcase their creativity in their local/regional area. He emphasized that this benefit should go to genuine organizations involved in Art and Culture which will benefit the society.
- 3. The Committee deliberated on functioning of the Scheme and made following suggestions to be placed before every meeting of NAC for review of ongoing projects sanctioned under TCC Scheme:-
- i) Physical and financial progress reports of the projects;
- ii) Photographs and videographs of project at different stages of construction;
- iii) Utilization status of the complexes vis-à-vis expenditure incurred with probable time frame for completion of the projects.

It was also decided that a proforma may be developed to monitor all the ongoing TCC projects.

- 4. After detailed deliberations on the views/suggestions and other inputs given by the members of the Committee, it was decided to form a Project Appraisal Committee under NAC to review cases of SI. No.1-4 placed at agenda item No.2 with the following composition:-
  - (i) AS&FA (Culture)

- Chairperson.

(ii) JS (P.Arts), MoC

- Member.
- (iii) DDG (Works), C.P.W.D
- Member.
- (iv) Any eminent Artist from NAC
- Member.
- 5. The Committee will examine the cases placed before NAC with reference to the following:
  - i) Examine existing Cultural Complexes in the States vis-à-vis
    - a) Population of the catchment area;
    - b) Distance of the proposed TCC project from the existing Cultural Complexes in the town/city/State where the project being planned;
    - c) Whether any TCC has been considered/sanctioned in the same City/District. If so, what is the outcome of the project.
  - ii) Whether the organization is predominantly involved in promotion of Art & Culture in the State.

- iii) Examine proposals based on no. of Cultural activities organized by the organization in the past (Both in terms of Qualitative & Quantitative parameters by providing videos/still photos).
- 6. The Committee will also suggest improvement to the Scheme:-
  - (i) In developing Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for better functioning of TCC projects and to achieve an effective and efficient quality output. Projects have made use of optimal & effective utilization of Central funds and to develop better monitoring mechanism.
  - (ii) Develop methodology for preparation of DPR, tendering process for the project authorities after sanction of Central Financial Assistance and to make record of Architects, Agencies, and Contractors etc. involved/engaged in each project.
  - (iii) Scheme should have provision for O&M of approved projects within the sanctioned grant.
  - (iv) Prepare an inspection proforma for carrying out the physical inspections and hiring of outsourced Agencies/third party for the same so as to ensure the detailed information about the project and effective monitoring of the projects.
  - (v) Take stock of existing Cultural Infrastructure in the State/District/Subdivision/City/Town and advise NAC whether any future Cultural Complex is required in the area.
  - (vi) To fix norms for construction for Cultural Complexes in Urban/Semi-urban areas, Universities etc.
  - (vii) To tender advice to the NAC in any matter regarding the functioning of the Scheme.
- 7. It was also decided that NSD will prepare a list of such places where performances are regularly organized but no infrastructure exists.
- 8. The committee thereafter deliberated upon the Agenda Items and took the following decisions:-
