Sahitya Akademi, announced its annual Sahitya Akademi Awards in 23 languages today. 07 books of poetry, 06 of novel, 02 of short stories, 03 Play/Dramas, 02 Literary Criticism, one each of Autobiographical Essays, Collection of Articles and Literary History have won the Sahitya Akademi Awards 2022. Award in Bengali language will be announced on a later date.

The Awards, recommended by distinguished Jury members in 23 Indian languages, were approved by the Executive Board of the Sahitya Akademi which met today under the Chairmanship of Dr. Chandrashekhar Kambar, President, Sahitya Akademi.
