His career started with writing poems. His first poetry collection was 'Shatabdir Artananda' and first story collection was 'Samudrar Sudha'. Smt Sanjukta Dasgupta said that he lives on and will live on as long as a culture or civilization survives. His creations are signposts of literary evolution. He wrote in Odia and also in English.
